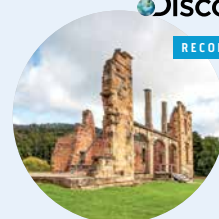

port arthur, tasmania

Echoes of the past still linger in the historic sites around this former penal colony, once so remote and inaccessible that it was nearly impossible for prisoners to escape. Today, this port city is the gateway to the stunning Tasman Peninsula with its towering rock formations jutting from the sea, along with a lavender farm and world-class vineyards, as well as a conservation area for endangered Tasmanian devils.
