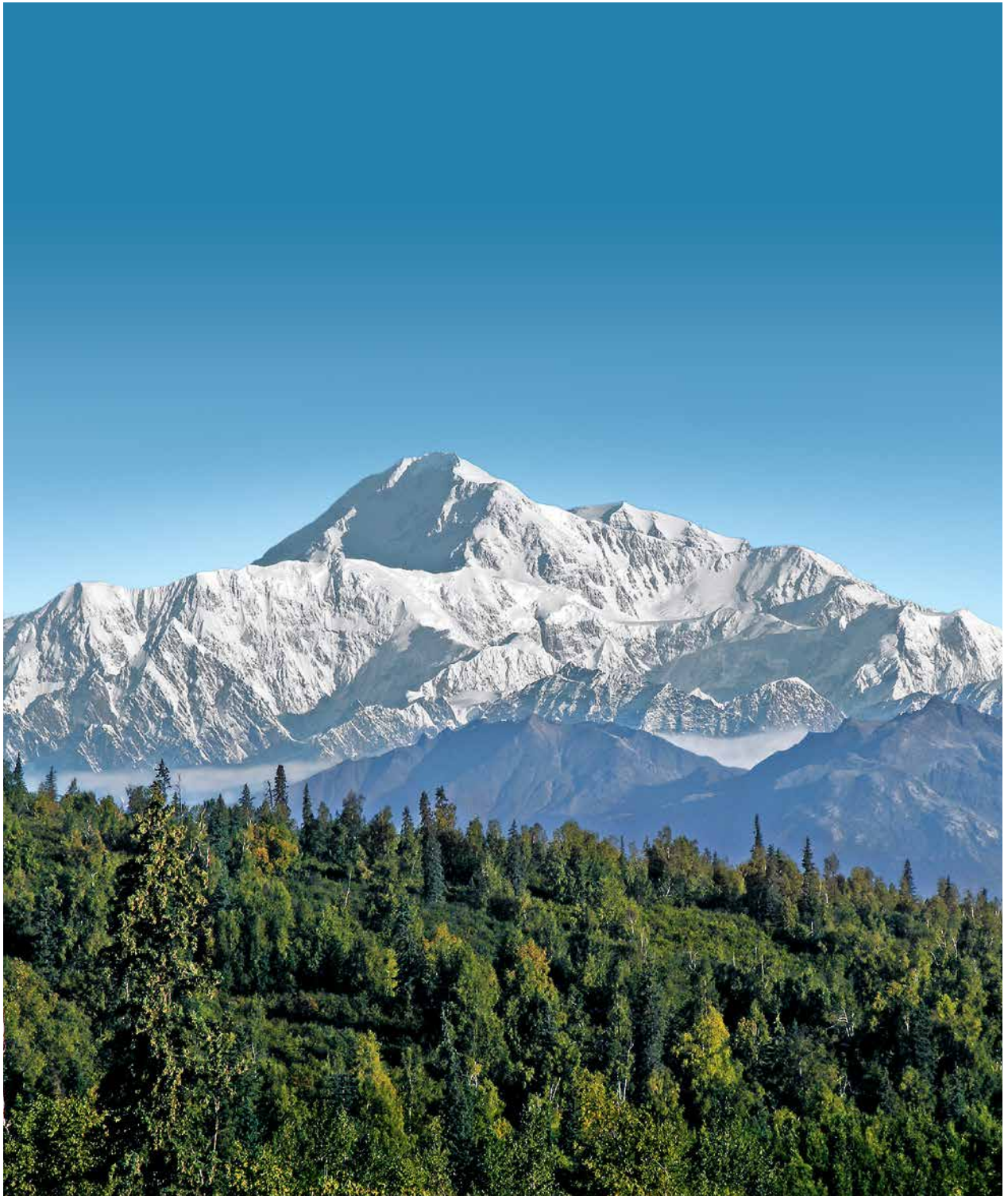

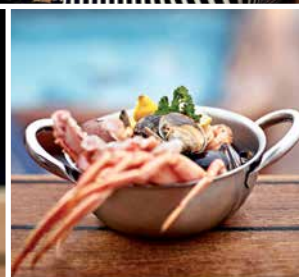

icy strait point

Near Alaska's largest Tlingit village lies the unique port of Icy Strait Point. Opened in 2004, Icy Strait Point features a restored salmon cannery that houses a museum, where you can discover the rich Native heritage of the Huna Tlingit tribe. Grab a bite at one of the restaurants in port or pick up a Native Alaskan made souvenir from the local arts and crafts shops around town. If adventure is calling your name, look no further than the world's highest zipline with a 1,300-foot drop!

more ashore

With a Late Night (9pm or later) port call in Juneau or Icy Strait Point on many sailings, your extended day allows more time in port to explore.



skagway

During the Gold Rush era, Skagway — gateway to the Klondike — boasted 20,000 residents and a variety of saloons, dance halls and gambling palaces. A stroll along the town's streets will transport you back to days of the Klondike Gold Rush, as will a ride aboard the vintage White Pass & Yukon Route Railroad to the Klondike Summit and Yukon.

MUSHER'S CAMP & SLED DOG EXPERIENCE

Experience Alaska's state sport with a dog sled ride and puppy play time at a summer training camp.



ketchikan

Charming Creek Street — one of Ketchikan's main attractions — was the town's red-light district during the Gold Rush days. Equally famous are Native totems on display at the Saxman Native Village and Totem Bight State Park, and the region's famed salmon fishing.

glacier bay national park

Princess takes more guests to Glacier Bay than any other cruise line, and this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier and Johns Hopkins Glacier. tracy arm fjord

Breathtaking Tracy Arm Fjord extends over 30 miles long, with nearly a quarter of its area covered in ice. In fact, it encompasses some of Alaska's largest glaciers, including the twin Sawyer Glaciers. You'll sail past snowcapped mountains and through steep granite canyon walls.



hubbard glacier

The largest tidewater glacier in North America, Hubbard Glacier's immense beauty and phenomenal blue hues are enchanting, even from afar. But it's when your cruise ship draws closer that its towering surface really impresses, dwarfing even the uppermost deck on your ship.



WHAT YOU'LL SEE

Renowned for its wildlife, you'll see whales, harbor seals and otters swim; and a wide variety of seabirds soar gracefully across the sky.



college fjord

Discovered in the northwest corner of Prince William Sound during the 1899 Harriman expedition, spectacular College Fjord and its glaciers were named after prestigious East Coast schools by the college professors who first laid eyes upon their majesty. Stretching for miles, these massive rivers of ice edge down from mountains and through valleys, dipping into the pristine waters of the fjord.



WHAT YOU'LL SEE

Watch the awe-inspiring process of glaciers calving, or dropping, enormous pillars of ice into the sea, as they crack and land with a thunderous splash.

tips for your trip

Whether this is your first or fourteenth trip with Princess®, you probably have several questions about the adventures awaiting you in port and on board. So we've compiled a few of the most common travel questions you might have to help you prepare for your trip.



Alaska-specific dining

From local halibut to king crab, dining throughout your cruise and cruisetour is a feast for the senses. And all your meals are included on board the ship, except for alcoholic beverages, some specialty drinks, sodas, certain snacks and some alternative dining venues. Delicious, freshly prepared meals are available on board our railcars and at our wilderness lodges, but all meals are at your own expense unless otherwise specified in the daily tour itinerary.

What should I wear on the ship?

Casual sportswear, including shorts, lightweight pants and jogging suits, is the order of the day both at sea and on shore in hotter climates. Just remember to bring a sweater or jacket for cool evenings and comfortable walking shoes for excursions. For evening dining, there are two designations for dress codes in our dining rooms: Smart Casual and Formal. When evening dress is Smart Casual, guests dress as they would for a fine restaurant at home. Inappropriate dinner wear, such as pool or beach attire, shorts, ball caps and casual jeans (with fraying and/or holes), is not permitted in the dining rooms. Shoes must be worn at all times. On Formal nights, appropriate attire includes evening gowns and cocktail dresses for ladies, and tuxedos, slacks with dinner jackets, or suits for men. Princess offers formal wear rental on all itineraries and this can be arranged prior to your cruise.

What documents do I bring?

You'll need your cruise Boarding Pass and Travel Summary, and airline tickets or airline eTicket receipts. In addition, you should bring with you a copy of the Cruise Passage Contract. All guests, including children, must travel with a passport, valid for at least six months after the completion of the cruise. You must also present vaccination certificates and other health documents if required for your particular ports of call. If you don't have the proper documentation, you will be prevented from boarding the flight or vessel without refund of the cruise fare and/or airfare, and you will be subject to any fine or other costs incurred by Princess. Please consult your travel agent or call Princess at 800.774.6237 for full details regarding documentation, as it is your obligation to determine what documents will be necessary.

What does the price include?

Your comprehensive cruise fare includes onboard accommodations, ocean transportation, meals, some nonalcoholic beverages and most entertainment. Excluded are meals at some alternative dining venues, meals on hosted land tours unless noted otherwise, transfers and items of a personal nature such as, but not limited to, spa services, shore excursions, beverages and some snacks, photographs, gratuities and medical services.

Do I need cash on my vacation?

One of the best things about cruising with Princess is the convenience of being able to sign for all your expenses and have them charged to your stateroom. When you check in for your cruise, you'll receive a Cruise Card (a personal identification card). The Cruise Card is used to access your personal shipboard account to which all purchases are charged. An itemized statement will be delivered to your stateroom prior to disembarkation. We accept the Princess Rewards Visa Card, Visa, MasterCard, Discover Card, Diners Club, Carte Blanche, the JCB Card,® China Union Pay Credit and/or

Debit Cards and American Express/Optima. U.S. currency, Canadian currency, British currency, Euro currency and traveler's checks are also accepted. Those paying by traveler's checks or cash will be required to leave a \$300 USD per person cash deposit with the Guest Services/Purser's Desk at the beginning of the cruise. Cruisetour guests will find that traveler's checks and major credit cards are widely accepted in most ports of call.

When will I receive my documents?

Princess eTickets allow you to access your booking details at any time. Upon confirmation, you can use the Cruise Personalizer® at princess.com to review the Passage Contract, view your reservation, complete all required Guest Immigration information and provide contact information. Approximately 120 days prior to the voyage departure date you will have access, via the Cruise Personalizer, to view and reserve shore excursions and Lotus Spa® appointments.

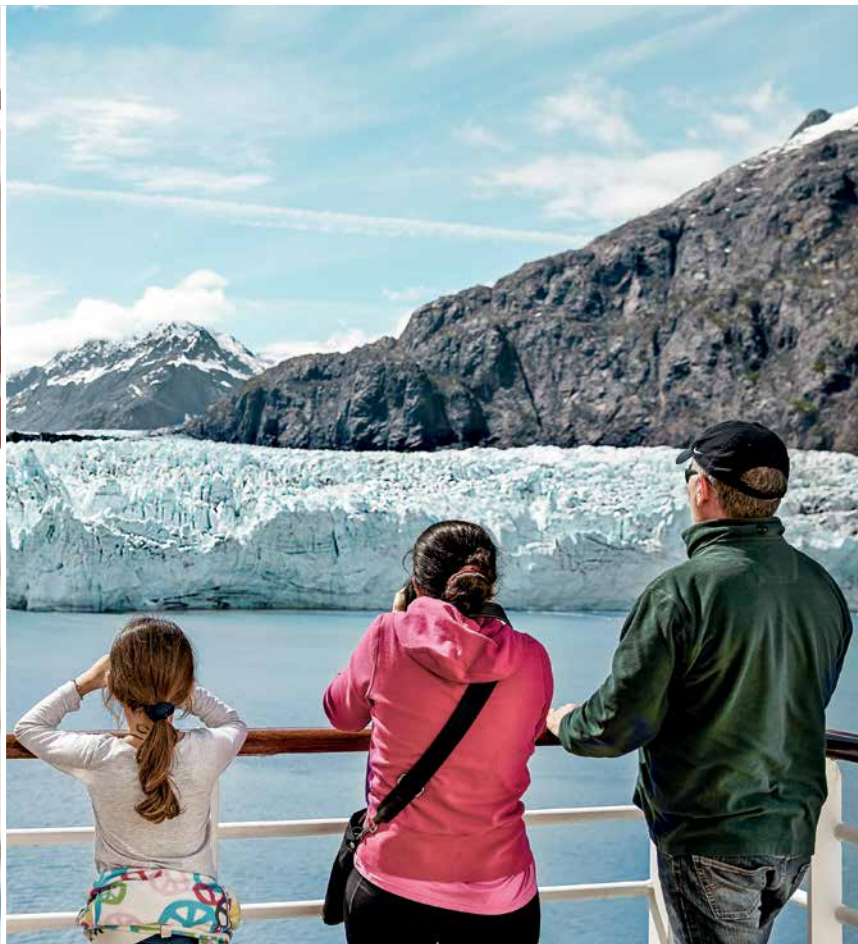
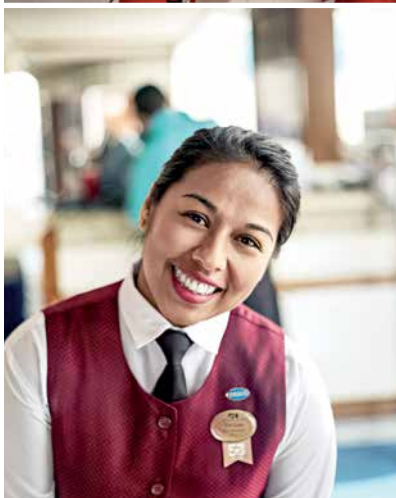
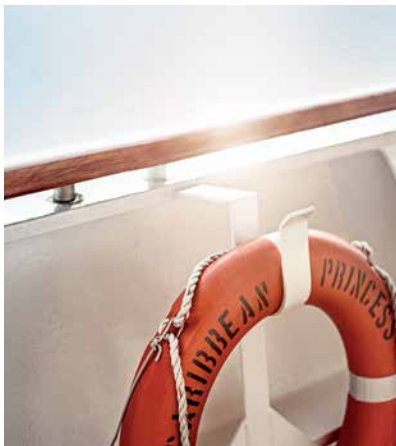
As part of our ongoing commitment to service innovation, Princess no longer mails pre-cruise documents. Instead, you will receive pre-cruise emails. You may print your Boarding Pass and personalized luggage tags within 75 days of sailing once your booking is paid in full and all required Guest Immigration information has been provided. If you do not have Internet access, your travel agent may assist you in securing the necessary information, or call Princess at 800.774.6237 for assistance.

Do you provide Express Checkout?

Like the finest hotels, Princess offers a quick and easy checkout service on board. Just register your credit card at embarkation or at the Guest Services/Purser's Desk as early as possible during your cruise.

What should I do about tipping?

During your cruise, regardless of which Princess ship you choose, you will meet staff who provide you with excellent service. Crew members often rotate to different vessels within



the Princess fleet, which helps to maintain our high standards on every ship. These dedicated workers reflect our philosophy that all crew on all ships are but one family who share in our success. To simplify the tipping process for our guests, a discretionary gratuity of \$15.50 per guest for Suites, \$14.50 per person for Mini-Suites (including Club Class), and \$13.50 per guest in all other staterooms per day (including children) will be automatically added to your shipboard account on a daily basis (excluding pre-paid charters). This gratuity will be shared among those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including all waitstaff, stateroom stewards, buffet stewards, and housekeeping staff across the fleet. For your convenience, this gratuity can be pre-paid before you sail by calling 1.800.774.6237 and referencing Special Services item number 0597.

A 15% gratuity is added to bar charges and dining room wine accounts. This is shared among the beverage staff and their support staff. There is also a 15% gratuity (5% on Australian-based ships) added to all spa services and fitness classes offered in the Lotus Spa,[®] Salon and Fitness Center.

Casino dealers and youth staff do not share in these gratuities, as not all guests utilize these services.

Please note that post-cruise adjustments to gratuities are not possible.

Do you offer travel insurance?

Yes, we strongly recommend the purchase of Princess Vacation Protection, which covers up to the full value of your trip in case you need to cancel or interrupt your trip. There will be no refund of cancellation or interruption fees by Princess. You must recover such fees from Princess Vacation Protection or other travel protection. How do I make arrangements for dining room seating and special diets?

Seating arrangements in the dining room are made by request on a first-come, first-served basis. To request Anytime Dining,SM Traditional first or second seating, special diets, or seating with a specific party, it is best to have your travel agent request your arrangements at the time of booking. Your dining arrangements will be shown on your Travel Summary.

What about clearing customs?

At the end of your cruise, customs and immigration inspectors will review your customs declaration form, on which you are to list all of the dutiable articles bought in foreign ports or in the ship's boutiques. U.S. residents returning to the United States are allowed a duty-free exemption of \$800 USD per person, which includes the cost of one liter of alcoholic

beverages, if purchased ashore, for each guest over 21 years of age. Canadian citizens, when out of the country for seven days or more, may bring back up to \$750 CAD duty-free. It is recommended that guests keep their sales receipts handy for declaring their purchases. Food items should not be landed in U.S. ports.

How can I be reached at sea?

To provide greater peace of mind while you're away from home, give friends and relatives information on how to telephone you while on your ship. Contact your phone company directly for rates, your phone company will charge you directly for calls made to the ship. When calling, please include guest name and stateroom number to ensure quick delivery. For ship phone numbers and more information, please visit princess.com/callship.
